



**Section 1 - Gather Account Information**

You must provide your Discovery FCU account information to your employer or payor to designate where the money will be deposited.

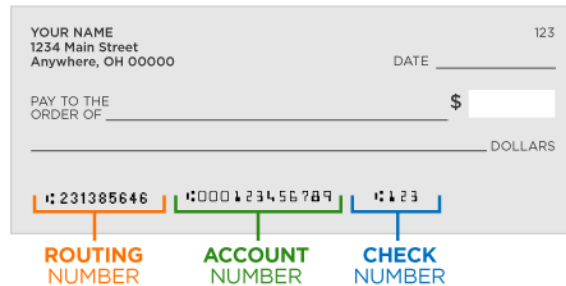

The account number printed on your checks is a cross reference account number and differs from your credit union member number.



When establishing or updating account information for direct deposits to your Discovery FCU Savings Account, please use your member number and Discovery FCU's routing number 231385646.

**Section 2 - Contact your Employer or Payor**

Contact your employer or payor directly with the information on this form. Your employer or payor may need you to complete a form provided by them and may request that you provide a voided check to process your request.

**Section 3 - Monitor your Discovery FCU Account**

Your direct deposit request may take one to two months for an employer or payor to process your request and to begin receiving electronic deposits.
